**Short Description:** PlayPosit is a free web application that allows us to create interactive video tutorials. This application runs in a browser and allows us to insert quiz questions into the video stream.

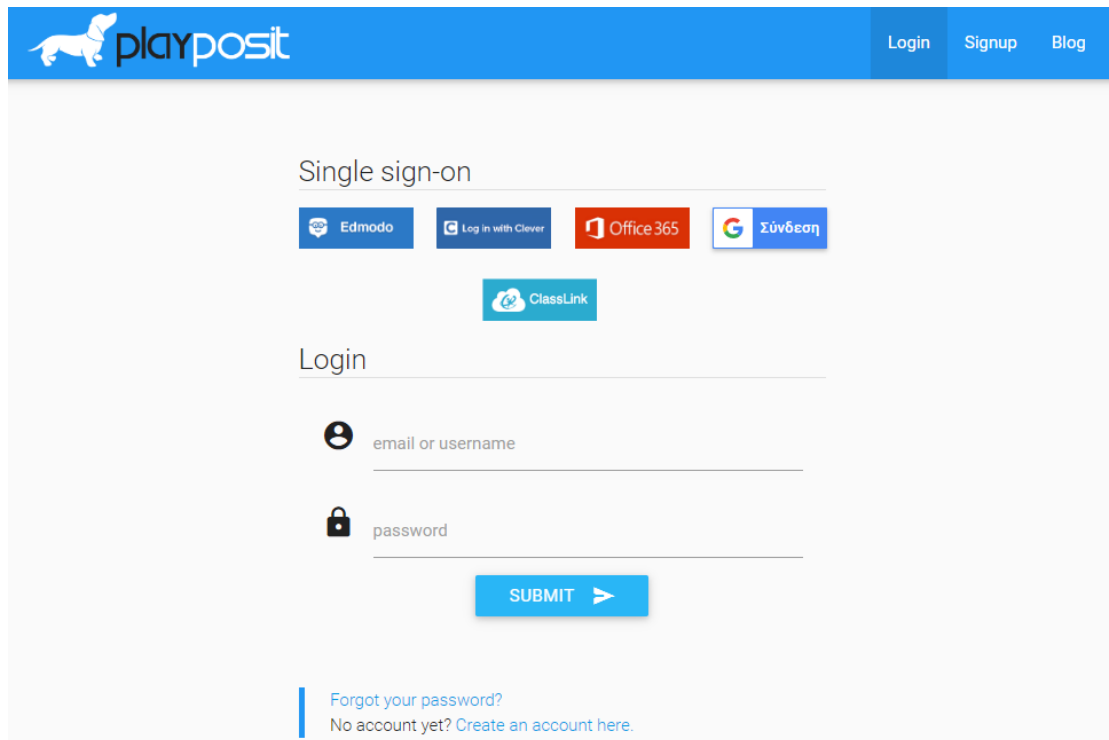
**Language:** Multilingual

**Key words:** multiple choice, interactive video, poll

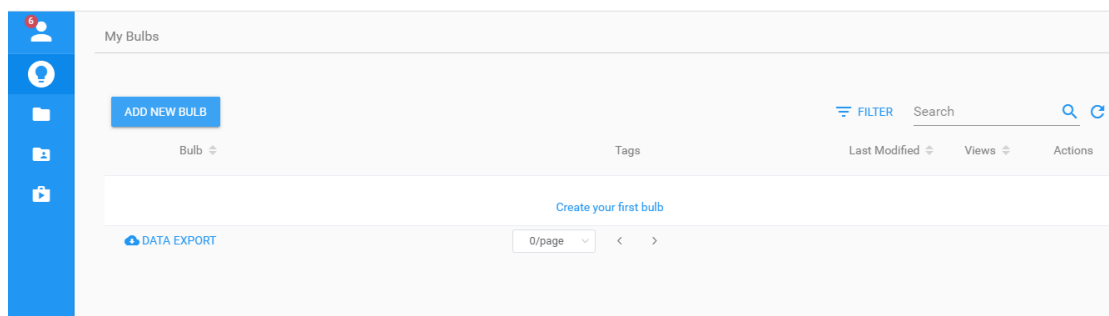

2. We can sign up in many ways as seen below.

3. Before we start the process of creating the video - lesson we need to find the video we will use on the internet and copy the url link.
4. We start by clicking the button ADD NEW BULB (See Fig. 2).

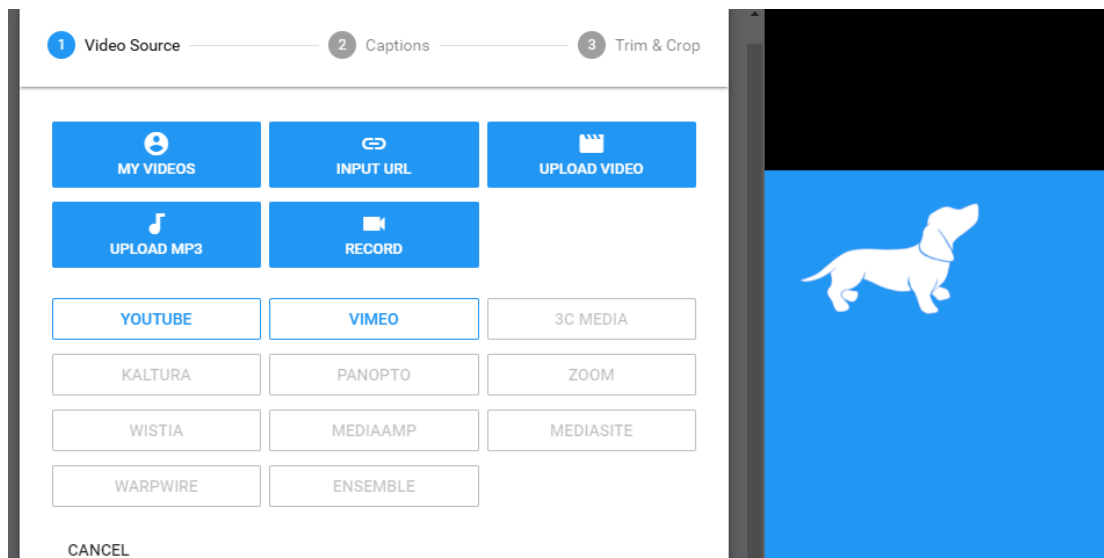


Fig. 3 Enter a video from a specific spot

5. Then in the new window (Fig. 3) that appears we can put the video we want by selecting the button INPUT URL, YOUTUBE or VIMEO. Additionally, we can load and select the UPLOAD MP3 button. (The UPLOAD VIDEO and RECORD buttons only work if we upgrade our account)

6. After inserting a video, we can insert some types of interactions, which are divided into three categories: Questions, Annotations and Templates and we'll see some examples of interactions.

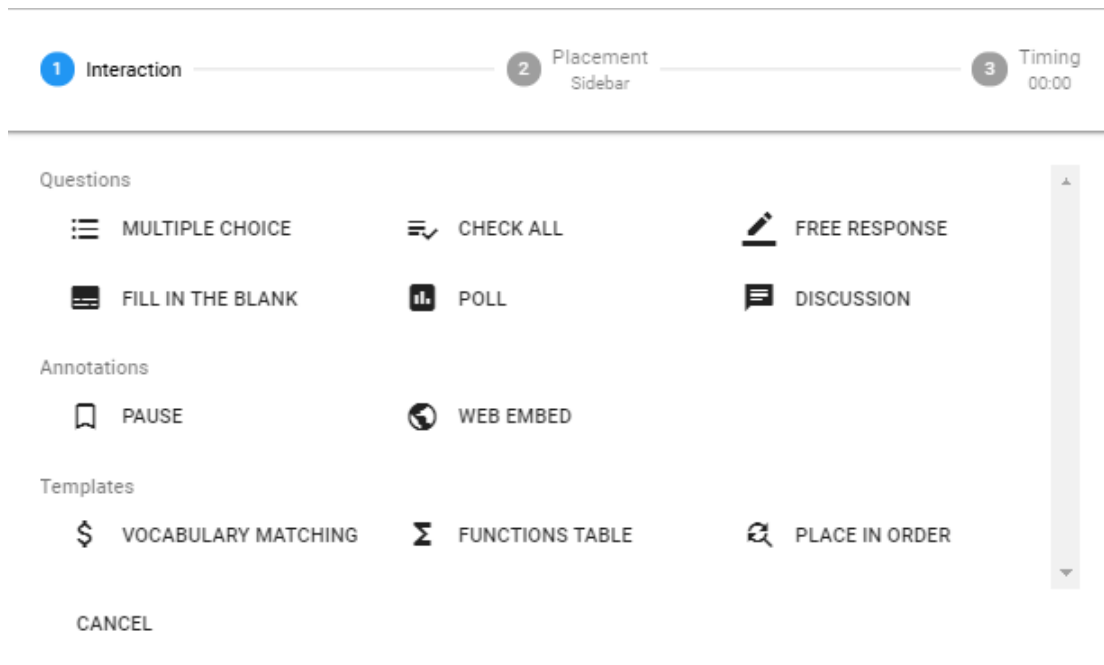



Fig.4 Many types of interaction




*Fig. 5 Multiple choice*

7. As it seems at the Fig. 5 below, we can enter the question with the possible answers for the 'multiple choice' interaction.
